

In the agricultural sector, SCODWES has successfully completed Integrated Watershed Management Programme in Uttara Kannada district and Savayava Bhagya Yojane Project in Tumakuru, Udupi and North Canara districts. I am also happy about the progress made by Farmers Producer's Organisation (FPO) in Sirsi, Rannebenur, Gadag & Haveri Taluk, assisted by Agriculture department & NABARD, towards improving the livelihood of small and marginal farmers. Through our Jal Jeevan Mission programme, envisioned to provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections in rural areas. Under NETFISH program, we have created awareness about hygienic and sustainable fish management across the coastal belt of Uttara Kannada, and extending to Goa. We have worked actively in the field of Resettlement and Rehabilitation by successfully implementing Karnataka State Highway Improvement Project-III and Karnataka Road Development Corporation Ltd. project.

## Education & Empowerment of Children and Youth

### CHILDLINE-1098 Sub-Centre, Sirsi: Project under Women & Child Development Department:

CHILDLINE 1098 is a national, 24 hour, free, emergency phone and outreach service for children in need of care and protection, linking them to long term rehabilitation. CHILDLINE India Foundation (CIF) provides the toll free phone service across India, monitoring the delivery of the service to the callers, financing the operation and training of personnel in order to provide relief and rehabilitation to children in distress.



Our organization has been selected for the CHILD LINE-1098 project on 27th December 2017 to set up the CHILDLINE sub-centre unit in Uttara Kannada (Karwar) district, Karnataka State. 423 cases of distressed children registered in Uttara Kannada district and immediate care and protection provided.

## Women Empowerment & Gender Equity

### Formation and Strengthening of SHGs

Women are organized in Self-Help Groups. They are provided various trainings for the capacity building and gender equity. Capacity development trainings on leadership skills have been conducted for the members of SHGs. Orientation on legal literacy & various skill development workshops were organized to SHG members & at the same time Income Generation Activity trainings were taken up on various skills. SHG members are empowered to establish business and enterprising ventures for making their livelihood on sustainable basis. Financial support in the form of loan is provided by NABFINS & ICICI to start small commercial setup of their own choice.



We have formed over 2400 women's Self-Help Groups (SHGs) in three districts, to economically empower marginalised rural women. At the SHGs, we run various vocational training courses, like Mushroom cultivation, Tailoring, Fashion designing, Bag Making, Beautician and Dairy Farming. Apart from training and preparing women for jobs or self-employment, we also support them through credit linkage. The combined micro-credit lending across our SHGs has crossed Rs. 100 crores so far.

### Santvana Mahila Kendra

Counseling for the victims of domestic violence & to provide legal assistance, temporary shelter, financial relief, training and rehabilitation to women who are victims of various atrocities such as dowry, rape, sexual harassment, domestic violence etc. Santvana centre is provided with a toll free number 1091. The helpline receives calls from women in distress round the clock. Facilities and rehabilitative services are provided to such women as per the recommendations of the District Level Committee depending on the merits of the case. Santvana Mahila Kendra started from February 2015, at Haliyal taluk, Uttara Kannada district

### Swadhar

Swadhar Greh implemented from 16.9.2019 in Sirsi of Uttara Kannada District, the scheme envisions a supportive institutional framework for women victims of difficult circumstances, so that, they could lead their life with dignity and conviction. It envisages that shelter, food, clothing, and health as



well as economic and social security are assured for such women. It also assures that the special needs of these women are properly taken care of and under no circumstances they should be left unattended or abandoned which could lead to their exploitation and desolation.

## Health, Sanitation & Environment

SCODWES have implemented 04 Mobile Medical Unit from June 2016, under national Health Mission & SCP & TSP, Dept. of Health & Family Welfare, Mobile Medical Unit implemented at Mayakonda, Jaglur, Kudligi and Sandur of Davanger and Ballari taluk of Davangere & Ballari district, under which the allotted villages & nearly 90 villages have been provided with primary medical services.

SCODWES have implemented 04 Mobile Medical Unit from November 2016, under national Health Mission Dept. of Health & Family Welfare, Mobile Medical Unit implemented at Sirsi, Yellapur, Ankola and Joida of Uttara Kannada district, under which the allotted villages & nearly 80 villages have been provided with primary medical services.

Operation of Public Health Centre, Mallapur, Karwar & Operation of Mobile Medical Health Unit for the villages around 16 kms from Kaiga Generating Station) (Sponsored by Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited – NPCIL). From 16<sup>th</sup> November implemented Operation of Public Health Centre, Mallapur, Karwar

The objectives of the scheme are as under:

- (1) To improve health care access to villagers residing within the 16 Kms radius of Kaiga Site.
- (2) To create awareness on improving health through counselling on various related issues.
- (3) To promote institutional deliveries as against home deliveries to avoid and eliminate maternal delivery deaths / infant deaths

**From 16.4.2020 to 18.5.2020, 702 patients treated at their doorstep**

An unique Initiatve, **Team Sanjeevini, COVID19 Medical Response Service, Bike Ambulance**, first of its kind in the state, Primary treatment on call at their doorstep, providing 3 contact Nos **as helplines**, was open from 8 am to 5pm.

The mobile ambulance, health service to the vulnerable and downtrodden communities, was useful for reaching out to patients in Urban & rural areas. To contain the spread of the virus and flatten the curve, the crucial step in maintaining the required hygiene standards & awareness. steps to ensure in preparing to face the challenge and threat posed by the growing pandemic of COVID-19 the Corona Virus.

Team of five bike ambulance, was available for the service, from 8am to 5pm, giving treatment for BP, Hypertension, Diabetic & other chronic illness. Health servies was provided on the basis of phone calls registered through the helplines Nos. facilitating treatment at their doorstep & providing free medicines & creating awareness on Covid19 among them.

## Primary health center – Castlerock & Joida

Primary health centers at Castlerock started from July 2020 & Diggi from September 2020 in Joida taluk of Uttara Kannada district.

The primary health center (PHC) funded by Department of Health & Family Welfare department, Govt of Karnataka is the basic structural and functional unit of the public health services, to provide accessible, affordable, and available primary health care to people.

To provide comprehensive primary health care to the community at PHCs & to achieve and maintain an acceptable standards of quality of care & to make the services more responsive and sensitive to the need of the community. Focusing on Infant immunization programs, anti-epidemic programmes, birth control programmes pregnancy and related care.
